What Expect: We provide Course materials, training and simulation equipment and medical kit samples are provided and/or coordinated with host organization. Plan to be outdoors 3/4 of the time and dress/layer accordingly. Students must read Wilderness and Remote First Aid Student Handbook PRIOR to Day One. Handbook has been sent as a downloadable PDF

Course topics include but are not limited to the assessing and treating of:

- Head and Spinal Injuries
- Bone Facture and Joint Injuries
- Cold and Heat Related Injuries
- Internal Injury Treatment for Major and Industrial Impact Injuries
- Wound Care to include, Lacerations, Punctures, Avulsions and Amputations

What Bring: Notebook/pen/pencils, water bottle, and camp chair

Optional items: Backpack, Sleeping Bag, Trekking/Ski Poles, Personal First Aid Kits, Rope

BWG will provide additional face masks and ppe for student use. We will also have Coffee, Hot Water for Tea and Snacks throughout the weekend.

Upon successful completion students will receive certification through The American Red Cross in Wilderness and Remote First Aid (2 Year Certification)

This 2-Day (16+ hour) course meets the anticipated medical needs of the following communities: Seasonal Outdoor Staff, Backcountry Trip leaders and Outdoor Industry Professionals and Guides. Our goal is to create and cultivate First Responders who can comfortably and confidently perform the skills and methods covered in this combined program.
