FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS AT CAMP

If you haven't heard yet, there is exciting news about the future of our camp program and facilities. The Council Executive Board recently approved the allocation of \$250,000 for facility enhancements at Camp Scouthaven to be completed before the summer 2023 camping season. Rooted in our goal of providing a world-class experience for youth and based on the feedback you provided us in recent surveys, we are pleased to announce facility, program, and equipment upgrades to enable additional summer camp and year-round camping experiences at Camp Scouthaven.

SITE 1 A PAVILION

The promise of a pavilion in every campsite is being delivered. These will be extremely beneficial to not only summer camp, but year-round camping as well. Many will feature solar power. Two new staff-style cabins are being added as well this fall. These initial projects getting done now give us more time in the spring for the next steps of camp improvements. LATE PAYMENT FEE

A \$25 late fee (per person) is applied to the final payment of each participant who does not complete the payment schedule on time.

LATE DIETARY REQUEST

A \$25 late fee (per person) will be charged to each participant who fails to request Dietary Accommodations at least two weeks before their camp session.

SUMMER CAMP REGISTRATION

WELCOME HOME!

We encourage you to start your summer camp registration process as soon as possible. Campsites, while not guaranteed, are assigned based on the order of registration received. Units that cannot fill 75% of a campsite may be assigned to share a campsite. You will have the option to request a campsite while completing your Session Deposit. While efforts will be made to accommodate the power necessary for CPAP machines, power is not guaranteed for any participant. In addition, our camp has a capacity limit for each session. This capacity is determined by bunk deposits. Once met all further bunk deposits will join a waiting list.

ADULT LEADERSHIP IN CAMP

All adults attending and staying overnight at Summer Camp MUST be registered (Paid Adult Registration) in the BSA and have valid Youth Protection Training. It is the Greater Niagara Frontier Policy that all adults must have a paid adult registration with the BSA. Any adult that arrives at Camp that does not have a current paid BSA registration and Youth Protection Training will not be permitted to stay overnight. Units must turn in a Roster showing Paid Adults (Merit Badge Counselor, Lion Partner, or Tiger Adult are not Paid Adult Positions) that are registered with their Unit by June 30, 2023. Two-deep leadership is required in camp at all times. Two adults must be at least 21 years of age or older. For co-ed or female units, one adult over 21 must be female.

HEALTH FORMS

The BSA Annual Health and Medical Record & GNFC OTC Form must be submitted for every youth and adult participant as required by the BSA and NYSDOH. Copies are available at, wnyscouting.org/Scouthaven

CAMPERSHIPS

Families in need of financial assistance are encouraged to apply for a GNFC Campership. No camperships are available for adults. Camperships can contribute up to 50% of a campers fee. Scouts crossing over and unsure of their summer plans are encouraged to still apply. Please go online to wnyscouting.org/Scouthaven to apply and learn more this winter. Campership applications must be received no later than 03/01/2022.
