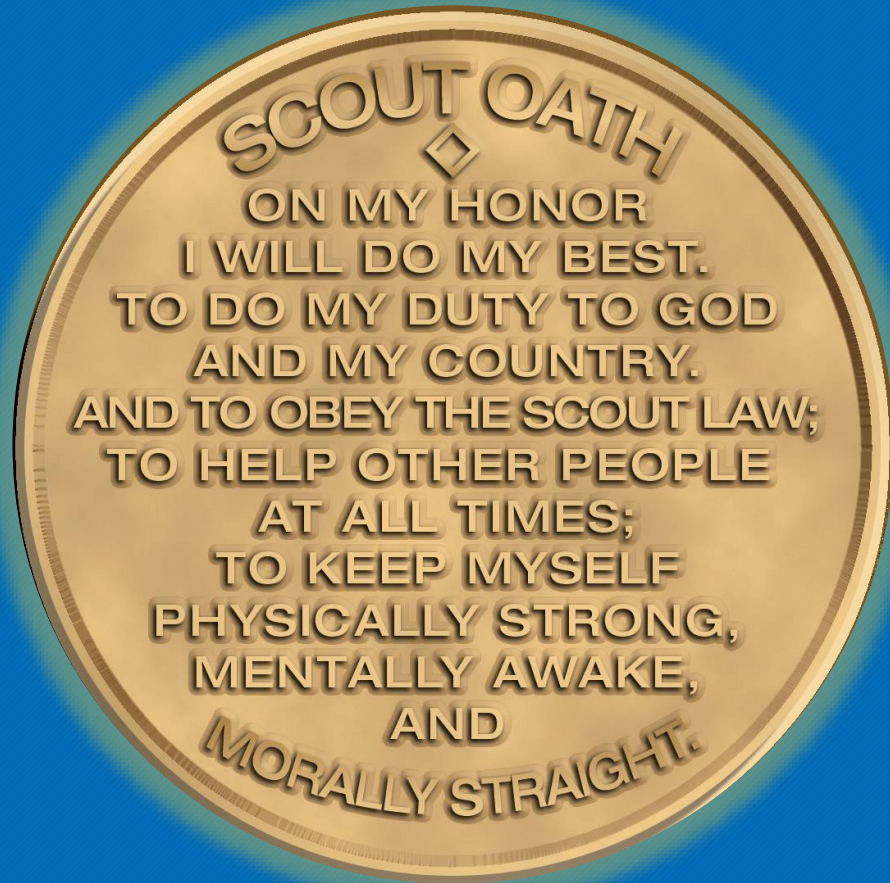


What is Cub Scouting?

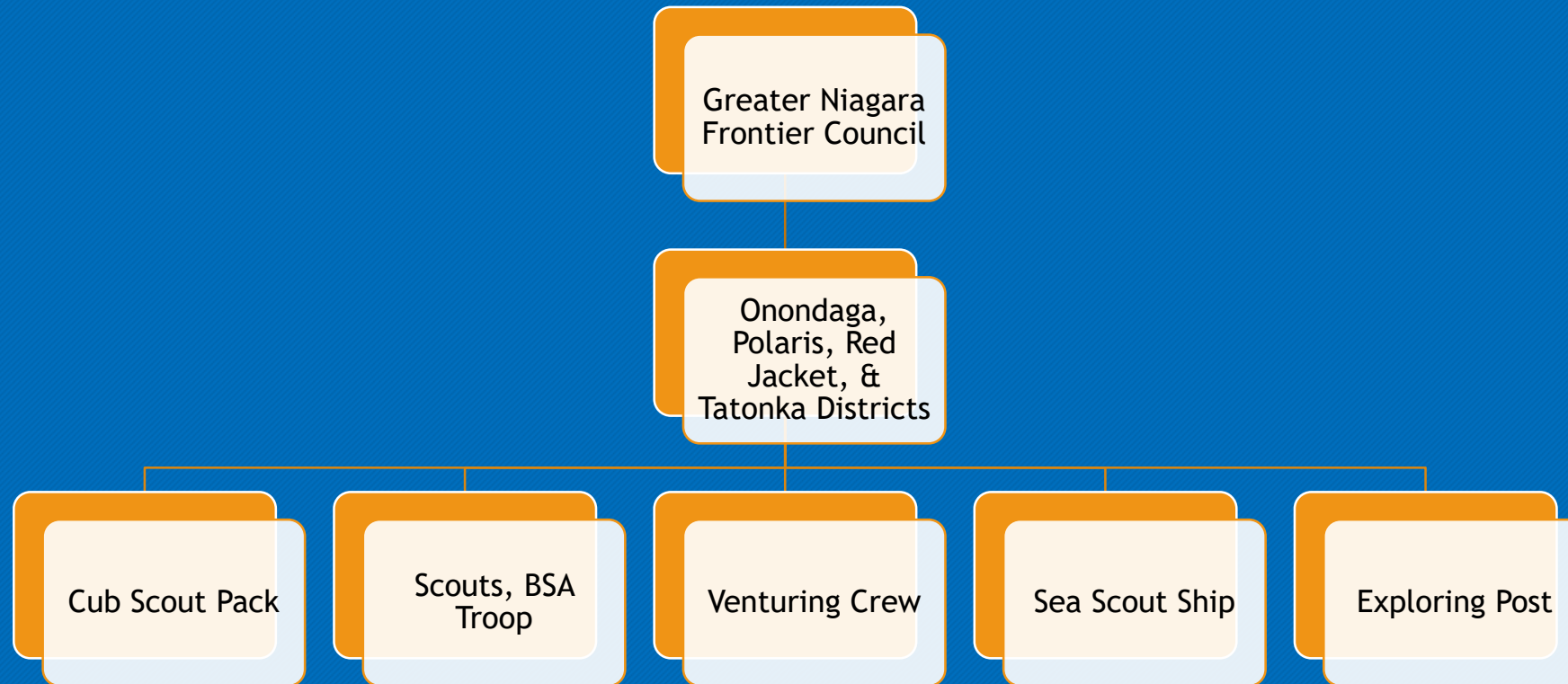

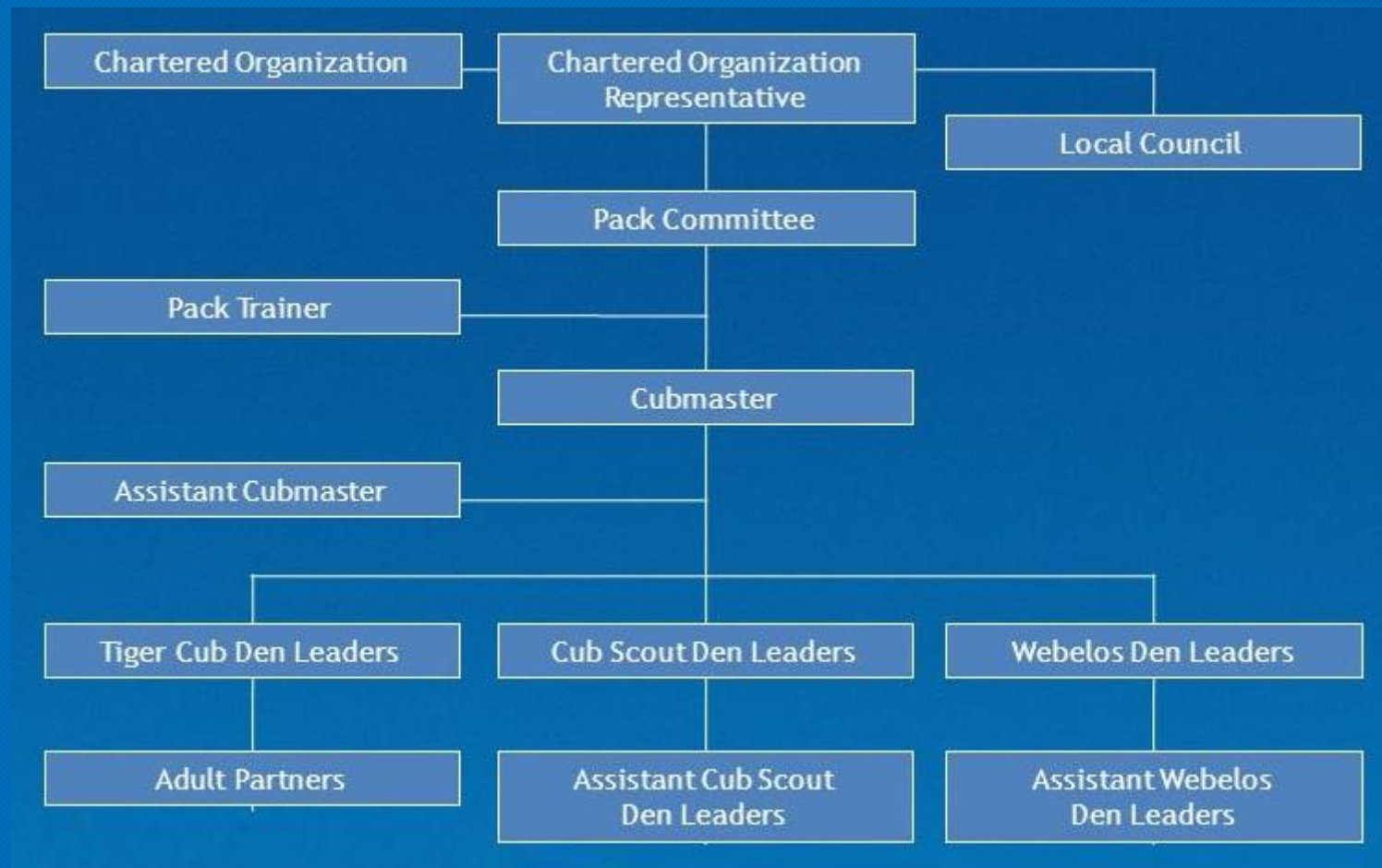
