## What is National Youth Leadership Training?

National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) is the premier 6 days, 4 nights outdoor leadership experience geared toward present and future leaders of Scouting. Participants will be engaged in hands-on training led by Western New York's finest youth staff. The training will cover skills essential to leadership within your unit, school and life activities. The training activities will mimic one month of a Scouts BSA Troop program. This program is youth led under the mentorship of trained adults who provide a safe and friendly Scouting environment.

## Who Can Attend?

1. Open to all Scouts age 13 and up. There can be no exceptions.
2. All participants must be a registered youth member of a Scouts BSA Troop, Venture Crew or Sea Scout Ship.
3. Scouts BSA members must have earned the rank of First Class and have completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops. Venturers and Sea Scouts must have completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews or Ships and have at least one year of camping experience.
4. Scouts must be recommended by their Unit Leader.
5. Scouts must have a properly completed BSA Health & Medical Record, parts A & B.
