Dear Cub Scout Leaders and Parents of Cub Scouts,

You may have heard that the BSA now requires all adults attending any Scouting activity for 72 hours or more to be registered members of BSA. This normally requires a registration fee, a completed adult membership application, and a current Youth Protection training certificate.

To remove any obstacles that could prevent you and your Cub Scout from attending camp this summer, we have arranged for parents who are not already registered with their child's Pack to be able to register with BSA for the month that they are attending Camp Scouthaven with their child. The council will cover the registration fee. To do this, the adult must fill out a BSA adult membership application and turn it in with a copy of their current Youth Protection training certificate. Applications are available at the Council Service Center, 2860 Genesee St., Cheektowaga, NY 14225, and online. The application must be filled out in its entirety and returned with the Youth Protection training certificate to the Council Service Center at least one month prior to the beginning of your camp session.

If you miss the deadline you will have to pay the pro-rated registration fee and process your application through your child's Pack through the end of the year.
