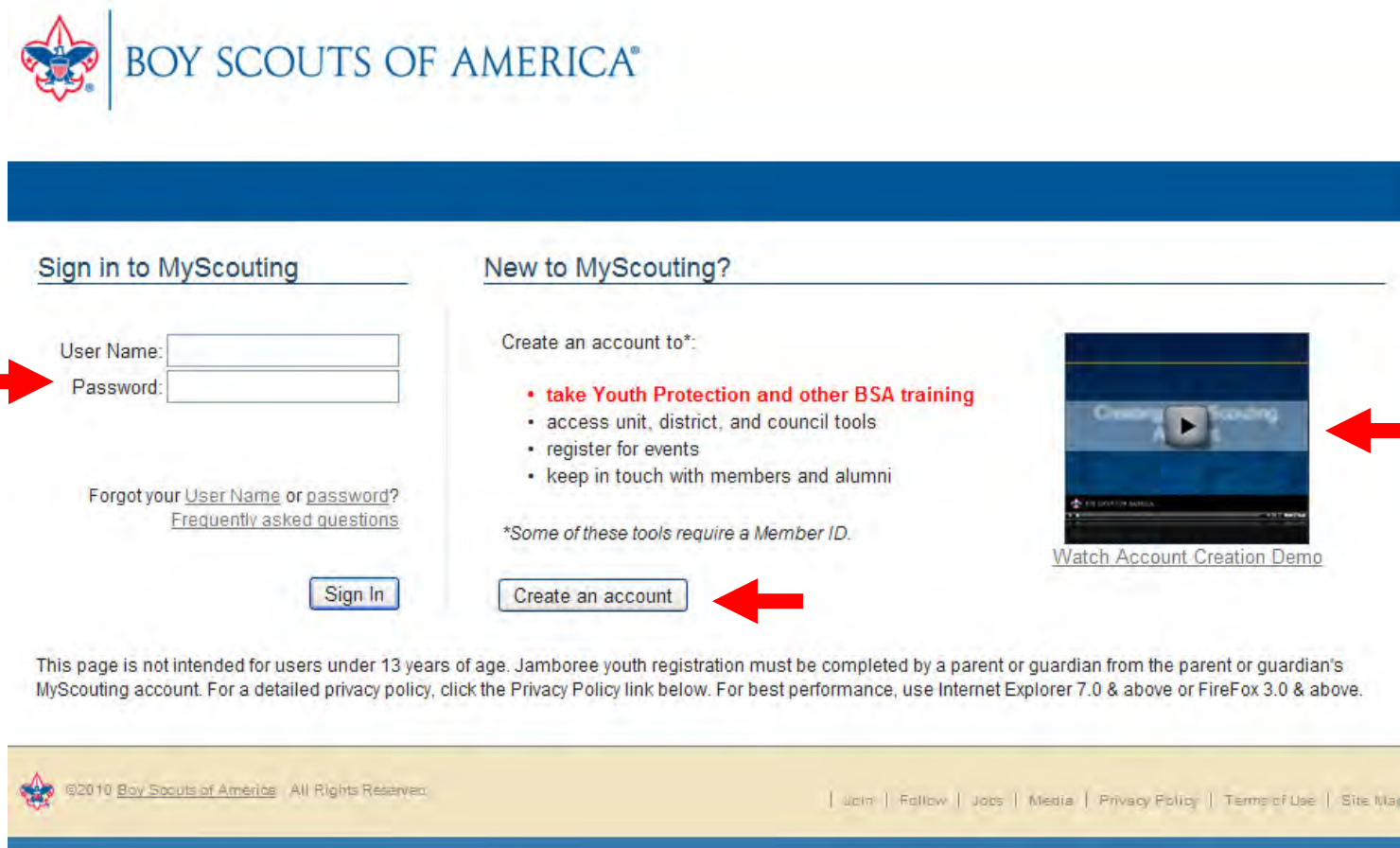


How to Find a Specific Online Training Module on MyScouting.org

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2. Log in to your Account using the ID and Password you previously created.

- If you don't have an Account, click the **Create an Account** button and follow the instructions.
- **NOTE:** When creating an online profile, please use the **SAME** name you used on your adult application. This will append your training to your existing record. Contact your unit leader if you don't recall how you entered your name on the application.
- Click the image on the right side of the screen to watch the **Account Creation Demo**.

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3. Once logged in, you will be on the initial MyScouting page.

Welcome to MyScouting!

Your MyScouting account gives you access to Scouting resources specific to your role in Scouting. These resources are intended to help you perform your Scouting duties most effectively.

Youth Protection Training Notice

You need not be a registered member or have a member ID to take Youth Protection Training. To take YPT:

1. From the menu on the left, click E-Learning.
2. From the General tab, scroll down to Youth Protection Training and click Take Course.
3. When you complete the course, print a certificate of completion to submit with a volunteer application, or submit the certificate to the unit leader for processing at the local council.

When your volunteer application is approved, you will receive a BSA membership card, which includes your member ID number. **You must enter this member ID into your MyScouting profile so that your local council has a record of the training you have taken online.** To do this, log into MyScouting, click My Profile, and enter your member ID number. This links your Youth Protection training, and any other MyScouting training, to your BSA membership.

4. Click on E-Learning under **Training** in the left-side navigation.

- Note the Training Validation option right under E-Learning. This allows individuals to verify what training they have taken and when. It also allows Unit leaders to verify training completed by their various registered leaders and volunteers.

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5. This takes you to a page showing **Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Venturing, and General** training categories; select the appropriate category.

- Scroll down within the category to find, click the specific training module you want and follow the instructions.

To be fully trained and earn the Trained Leader emblem*, a new leader must complete basic training in the following order:

Youth Protection Training: New leaders are required to take Youth Protection training before submitting an application for registration. The certificate of completion for this training must be submitted at the time the application is made and before volunteer service with youth begins. Youth Protection Training must be completed every two years to remain current.

Fast Start Training for their volunteer position.

Leader Position-Specific Training: Fully trained leaders changing leadership roles should take the Leader Position-Specific Training for their new position.

Orientation Training: This is Scouting

* In addition, Boy Scout leaders must complete Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills Training through their local council.

Important: The required courses are different based on program. Click on either Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Venturing, or General depending on what program you are taking training for. After clicking on the program, scroll down to Youth Protection Training and click Take Course.
